In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Vincent Bidwell of Buffalo N.Y. Owner

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he is a resident of the District of Buffalo Creek N.Y. and is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Steam Boat or Vessel called the Troy of Buffalo whereof A. M. Sprin is at present Master; and as he hath sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Mansfield City State of Ohio in the year 1845 as appears by the Copy of her last enrollment dated at this port 26 October 1853 No 124, the original enrollment of said Steam Boat having been lost as appeared by the Affidavit of Wm. T. Furbyle full owner, and on file in this Office

And the said enrollment the said Steam Boat or Vessel has two decks and one Mast and that she measures 546 tons 47 ninety-fifths her length is 182 feet 6 inches her breadth 27 " 6 " her depth 11 " 4 1/2 "

And the said Vincent Bidwell has no fallies and head having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said
