In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and ~~"An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam" passed 7th July, 1838 and the Act of August 30th, 1852 amending the same;~~ also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Myron Gage, Mariner, of Hanover Chautauque County New York  
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Hanover in the District of Buffalo Creek and owns one equal undivided half part of the Schooner *Caana* of Buffalo and is the Managing owner of said Schooner and that Isaac Eagle Ruben Gage both of said Hanover, each owns one equal undivided fourth part of said Schooner and that all said owners are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owners of the Schooner *Caana* of Buffalo or Vessel called the *Caana* of Buffalo whereof said Isaac Gage is at present Master; and as he hath sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Silver Creek State of New York in the year 1843, as appears by her last Enrollment dated at this Port July 21, 1858 No 107 now surrendered having changed owners

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 77 feet 6 inches her breadth 13 " 9 " her depth 5 " 9 " and that she measures 59 tons 37 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square stern and no figure head

And the said Myron Gage having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N Y.
