In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Olou Norton of Irving N.Y. Owner

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he is a resident of the District of Buffalo Creek and is so

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner James Lee or Vessel called the James Lee of Buffalo whereof Olou Norton is at present Master and as he hath sworn Olou Norton is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Irving State of New York in the year 1852, as appears by New last enrollment dated at this Port June 8, 1852 No 85 now surrendered having changed

And the said Enrollment Olou Norton having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has One deck and Two masts her length is 87 ft & 8 inches her breadth 19 " " 3 " her depth 6 " " " and that she measures 100 tons 24 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a Square Stern and a Berth head

And the said Olou Norton and Olou Norton head having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
