In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Rufus R Johnson of Buffalo N.Y. Managing owner

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he is a resident of the District of Buffalo Creek N.Y. and owned one equal undivided 1/3rd part of the Schooner Etwa of Buffalo that David R. McCorm of Buffalo N.Y. is the owner of one equal undivided 1/3rd part of said vessel and that Charles W. Miller of Buffalo N.Y. is the owner of the remaining one equal undivided 1/3rd part of said vessel and am:

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner Etwa of Buffalo whereof Abram Nicols is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Silver Creek State of New York in the year 1841 and rebuilt in the year 1843, as appears by her last enrollment dated at this port April 21 1854 No 66 now surrendered having changed owner

And said enrollment the said Schooner or Vessel has One deck and Two masts having certified that her length is 84 feet 7 in and that her breadth is 19 " 4 " and that she measures 94 tons 71 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has No guns

And the said Rufus R Johnson and head having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
