In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better securing of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852 amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he is a resident of the District of Buffalo Creek NY and is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Brig I Waffle or Vessel called the  
Mohogon of Buffalo whereof  
is at present Master; and as he hath sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at New State of  
Michigan in the year 1847 as appears by the Enrollment dated at this  
port of 29 October 1852 No 126 has amended having changed  
name

And the said Enrollment  
the said Brig or Vessel has One Deck and Two Masts having certified that  
her length is 115 feet 10 inches and that  
her breadth is 24 " 9 1/2 "  
her depth is 9 " 5 "  
and that she measures 248 tons 95 ninety-fifths  
that she is a Brig has

And the said Orville W. Ramsey and head  
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with  
the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N Y.  
Given under my Hand and Seal of Office, at the Port of Buffalo,  
in the said District, this 30 day of June  
in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty four
