In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and ~~"An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam,"~~ passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 20th, 1850 ~~amending the same~~; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Evans in the District of Buffalo Creek and is the Managing owner of the Scow called "The Watchman" and owns one equal undivided half part of said scow and that Hiram B. Ostrum resides at said Evans and owns the remaining one equal undivided half part of said scow, and that both said owners are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owners of the Scow Watchman of Buffalo or Vessel called the Watchman of Buffalo whereof said Dingman is at present Master; and as he hath sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Evans New York State of New York in the year 1854, as appears by the certificate of John G. Dingman Ship Carpenter her builder on file in this office

And Phorion Hoffman Surveyor having certified that the said Scow or Vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 71 feet & 1 inch

her breadth 17 " 1 " her depth 4 " 0 " and that she measures 43 tons 72 ninety-fifths that she is a Scow has a square stern and a square head

And the said Garrett H. Dingman having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Scow has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N.Y.
