In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same, also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he is a resident of the District of Buffalo New York, and is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Brig whereof is at present Master; and as he hath sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Milan, Ohio in the year 1842 as appears by her last enrollment dated at the Port of Detroit 19 of April 1853 No 44 now surrendered having changed owner

And the said Enrollment she said Brig or Vessel has One deck and Two masts having certified that her length is 91 feet 3 in her breadth 23 " 9 1/2 her depth 8 " 16 7/8 and that she measures 167 tons 45 ninety-fifths that she is a Brig and has a square Stern and a Perle head

And the said Elijah R. Bruce and head having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N Y.

Given under my Hand and Seal of Office, of the Port of Buffalo, in the said District, this 20 day of June in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty four
