In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and ~~an Act to provide for the better carrying of the mail of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam, passed 17th July, 1838 and the Act of August 30th 1852 amending the same~~ also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

And the record of said Enrollment in this office having certified that
the said Schooner or Vessel has one deck and two masts and that
her length is sixty eight feet and three inches 68 ft. 3 in
her breadth sixteen feet & seven inches 16" 7"
her depth seven feet & two inches 7" 2"
and that she measures 72 tons 92 ninety-fifths
that she is a Schooner has no gally & a square stern
and no figure head

And the said Thomas J. Tyler having
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with
the terms of the said acts, the said
has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N Y.
