In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Henry C. Walker of Buffalo District of Buffalo Creek, N.Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Buffalo and owns one half part undivided of the Barque "Great Wat" of Buffalo and is her managing owner and that Isaac C. Walker who resides at the same place owns the remaining one half part undivided of said Barque; and that both said owners are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owners of the Barque "Great Wat" of Buffalo whereof Marshall Capron is at present Master; and is her Master sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo in the State of New York in the year 1854, as appears by the certificate of George S. Weeks, shipwright her builder on file in this office

And Thos. Hoffman Surveyor having certified that the said Barque or Vessel has one deck and three masts and that her length is - 184 feet and 8 inches her breadth - 33 " " 4 " 3 her depth 13 " " 3 " 3 and that she measures 765 tons 53 ninety-fifths that she is a - Barque has a square stern and no figure head

And the said Henry C. Walker having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Barque has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N.Y.
