In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better sailing of the lines of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Refus R. Johnson, Merchant of Buffalo N.Y.
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Buffalo in the District of Buffalo Creek; that he is the managing owner of Schooner called the Montgomery; that himself and David R. Morse of the same place each own one equal undivided half part of said Schooner and are both

Citizen of the United States, and sole owners of the Schooner Montgomery of Buffalo or Vessel called the Montgomery of Buffalo whereof William H. Johnson is at present Master; and as he hath sworn William H. Johnson is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Cleveland State of Ohio in the year 1847, as appears by her last Enrollment dated at this Port April 2^d, 1853 No 35 now surrendered having changed owners

And said Enrollment William H. Johnson having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 113 feet 6 2 inches her breadth 25 " 3 " her depth 9 " 24 8 " 6 1/2 " and that she measures 51 tons 51 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square stem and scull head

And the said Refus R. Johnson having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner Montgomery has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N Y.
