In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 20th 1850 amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Elijah K. Bruce, Merchant, of Buffalo District of Buffalo Creek  
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Buffalo and is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner Expulior Expulior whereof H. Kott is at present Master, and as he hath sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Milauy St State of Ohio in the year 1847 as appears by her last Enrollment issued at this port July 22<sup>d</sup> 1853. No. 14, which has been lost as appears by the affidavit of W. A. Fox on file in this office

And the record of said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 112 feet 8 1/2 inches her breadth 24 " " 0 " her depth 10 " " 0 " and that she measures 247 tons 55 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a scroll

And the said Elijah K. Bruce head having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
