having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he is a resident of the District of Buffalo Creek N.Y.

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner *John K. Poole* or Vessel called the *John K. Poole* whereof *John K. Poole* is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *DePue* State of *Wisconsin* in the year 1848, as appears by Her last enrollment dated at *this port* 22 June 1854 No 136 Now Surrendered having changed owner.

And the said Enrollment the said Schooner or Vessel has *One deck* and two masts having certified that her length is *68 ft 3 in* and that her breadth is *16 ft 7 in* and her depth is *7 ft 2 in* and that she measures *72* tons *92* ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has *no gallery & a square stern* and *no figure head*

And the said *Elijah N. Bruce* and *John K. Poole* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N.Y.
