



# ENROLLMENT.



## District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and ~~"An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838,~~ and the Act of August 30th, 1854, ~~in force,~~ also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

James F. Snow & Cyrus Clark, both of Buffalo  
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that they both reside at Buffalo in the District of Buffalo Creek; and that the said Snow owns one equal undivided fourth part of said Schooner <sup>Autumn of Buffalo</sup> and that said Clark owns the remaining three equal undivided fourth parts of said Schooner, and both of said owners are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owners of the said Schooner \_\_\_\_\_ in Vessel called the Autumn of Buffalo \_\_\_\_\_ whereof said Snow \_\_\_\_\_ is at present Master; and as he hath sworn \_\_\_\_\_ is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Spring in the State of New York in the year 1854, as appears by her last Enrollment issued at this port June 29, 1854 No 143 now surrendered having changed owners.

And said Enrollment \_\_\_\_\_ having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 130 Feet & 3 inches her breadth 26 " " 0 " her depth 11 " " 0 " and that she measures 345 tons 15 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square stern and a scroll head

And the said Snow & Clark having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner \_\_\_\_\_ has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N Y.
