PORT OF BUFFALO.

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In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 20th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

William Sutton Merchant of Buffalo City of Buffalo Creek Managing owner having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Buffalo New York and is the Managing Owner of the Propeller "Opomba" of Buffalo that he together with George Davis, Daniel A. Morgan residents of said Buffalo and of Wm. Mookletto who resides at the City of New York, Compose the firm of Davis, Sutton & Company and as such formed, own one equal undivided part of said Propeller and that Wm. Mookletto who resides at Piquette Ohio, owns the remaining one equal undivided half part of said Propeller, and all the said vessel and

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Propeller "Opomba" of Buffalo whereof William Sutton is at present Master; and as he hath sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Ohio City State of Ohio in the year 1848, as appears by New last enrollments dated April 17th 1854 now surrendered having changed owners

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has One deck and One Mast, and that her length is 152 feet 7 inches and her breadth 22 feet 9 1/2 inches and her depth 10 feet 3 1/2 inches and that she measures 37 tons ninety-fifths and that she is a Propeller and a square Sloop

And the said William Sutton agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
