In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1850 amending the same, also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Samuel L. Watson of Buffalo New York, District of Buffalo Creek having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Buffalo and is the managing owner of the Schooner Lewis Cass of Buffalo and owns the one equal undivided half part thereof; that Charles McEua of said Buffalo owns the remaining one equal undivided half part of said schooner; that both said owners are

Citizens of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner Lewis Cass of Buffalo — whereof said McEua is at present Master; and as he hath sworn McEua is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Black River State of Ohio in the year 1846, as appears by the last Enrollment dated at this Port June 24, 1854. now surrendered having changed owner — said Enrollment by No. 140 —

And said Enrollment McEua having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 97 feet 8 inches her breadth 23 " 10 " her depth 9 " 2 " and that she measures 191 tons 79 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square stern and a scroll head

And the said Samuel L. Watson having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
