In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Andrew R. Cobb of Buffalo New York

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo aforesaid, is the Managing owner of the Propeller Donny of Buffalo. and owned Eight equal undivided twelfth parts of said Propeller, and that Nicholas Gibbard of Buffalo New York owned One equal undivided twelfth part of said Propeller, and that Andrew Anderson who resides at said Buffalo owned two equal undivided twelfth parts of said Propeller, that Cornelius J. Deaconson who resides at said Buffalo and owned One equal undivided twelfth part of said Propeller and all said owners, are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the said Propeller "Donny" of Buffalo whereof Andrew Anderson is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo New York in the year 1854, as appears by New last enrollment dated at this Port April 29th 1854, no 99. Now surrendered having changed owners

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has One deck and One masts and that her length is 191 feet and 11 inches her breadth 28 " " " " her depth 12 " " " " and that she measures 629 tons 32 ninety-fifths and has No spar and No foremast head

And the said Andrew R. Cobb has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y. Given under my Hand and Seal of Office, at the Port of Buffalo, in the said District, this 24 day of July in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty four
