her breadth *14 " 6 inches*
her depth *8 " 0 "*
and that she measures *106* tons *57* ninety-fifths
that she is a *Canal Boat* has a square stern and no figure head

agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with
the terms of the said acts, the said *Canal Boat* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N Y.
