In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Richard Mott

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner *Ruth* or Vessel called the *Richard Mott* whereof *James Anderson* is at present Master; and as he hath sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo in the year 1854; as appears by the certificate of *B. B. Jones*, Superintendent in and for the office

And *Phoson Hoffman Meadorn* the said Schooner or Vessel has *One deck* and *Two masts* having certified that her length is *124 feet 6 in* her breadth *26 "* her depth *10 "* and that she measures *296* tons *94* and that she is a Schooner and *No figure* head

And the said *Robert Montgomery* agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N Y.
