In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Wells D. Walbridge of Buffalo N. Y.  
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Canal Boat \_\_\_\_\_ or Vessel called the  
S. P. Perkins of Buffalo - whereof C. Madden of Rochester is at present Master; and as he hath sworn  
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Rochester - State of  
New York in the year 1853 - as appears by the Certificate of J. J. Calmudge  
Shipwright on file in this office

And P. Hoffman Measurer having certified that  
the said Canal Boat or Vessel has one deck and no masts - and that  
her length is 83 feet 3 inches.  
her breadth 14 " 6 "  
her depth 8 " 8 "  
and that she measures 717 tons 19 ninety-fifths  
that she is a Canal Boat has a square stem and no figure

And the said Wells D. Walbridge  
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with  
the terms of the said acts, the said Canal Boat has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
