In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lines of Passengers on Board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 20th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Moses Smith of Buffalo New-York

having taken or subscribed the oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he is a resident of
Buffalo, and is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner *William Drury* or Vessel called the *William Drury* whereof *William Drury* is at present Master; and as he hath sworn
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Sheffield* in the State of *Ohio* in the year 1835, as appears by And rebuilt in the State of *New York* in the year 1854, as appears by her last enrollment dated at this port May 20th 1854. Now surrounded having changed owners

And the said enrollment she said Schooner or Vessel has *Quebeck* and *two masts* having certified that her length is *111* feet and *3* inches her breadth *21* " " *9* " her depth *6* " " *6* " and that she measures *141* tons that she is a *Schooner* and has a *Square Stern* *71* tons *95* head

And the said *Moses Smith* and *William Drury* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Schooner* has been duly Enrolled at the *Port of Buffalo, N. Y.*
