In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better sailing of the line of ~~Buffalo~~ ~~on~~ ~~and~~ ~~Buffalo~~, propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1836, and the Act of August 20th, 1852, ~~and the~~ also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Elijah H. Bruce of Buffalo New York, managing owner  
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo  
and is the Managing owner of the schooner Hope of Buffalo and owns  
one equal undivided half part of said Schooner; that ~~Thomas~~ Mills, of  
the same place owns the remaining one equal undivided half part of said  
Schooner and is a citizen that both said owners are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owners of the said Schooner \_\_\_\_\_ or Vessel called the  
Hope of Buffalo \_\_\_\_\_ whereof said Mills \_\_\_\_\_ is  
is at present Master; and as he hath sworn \_\_\_\_\_ is a

her length is 119 feet 4 1/2 inches

and that she measures 249 \_\_\_\_\_ tons 83- \_\_\_\_\_ ninety-fifths  
that she is a Schooner \_\_\_\_\_ has a square stem \_\_\_\_\_ and a scroll \_\_\_\_\_ head

And the said Elijah H. Bruce \_\_\_\_\_ having  
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with  
the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner \_\_\_\_\_ has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N Y.
