In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th 1852, amending the same, also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

William O. Brown of the City of Buffalo Dist. of Buffalo Creek having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo aforesaid; that he is the Executor of the Estate of Ferdinand C. Clark deceased and as such Executor owns and holds the Brig Globe of Buffalo. that said Clark was and said Brown is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Brig Globe of Buffalo or Vessel called the Globe of Buffalo whereof C. H. Wheaton is at present Master; and as he hath sworn C. H. Wheaton is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1844, as appears by her last Enrollment dated at this Port March 27, 1852 No 31 now surrendered by reason of change of ownership

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Brig or Vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 131 feet and 4 inches her breadth 26 " 3/4 " her depth 10 " 3/4 " and that she measures 319 tons 77 ninety-fifths that she is a Brig has two galleys and a swell head head

And the said William O. Brown having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N Y.
