In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and ~~"An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1850 amending the same;~~ also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

William O. Brown, of Buffalo in the district of Buffalo Creek having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Buffalo and is the Executor of the last will and Testament of the late Ferdinand C. Clark and is a

as such Executor is
Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Brig Old Fellow of Buffalo whereof O. S. Harper is at present Master; and as he hath sworn O. S. Harper is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Cleveland State of Ohio in the year 1845, as appears by her last Enrollment dated at this port April 7th 1849 No 12, now surrendered by reason of change of ownership

And said Enrollment 3 having certified that the said Brig or Vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 107 feet & 9 inches her breadth 24 " 4 " her depth 9 " 4 " and that she measures 234 tons 94 ninety-fifths that she is a Brig has 3

And the said Ferdinand C. Clark and William O. Brown head having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N Y.
