In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he is the owner, of one equal undivided half part of the Schooner *Kath Star* of Buffalo and residing in the District of Buffalo New York, that James O Callahan who resides at Chicago Illinois is the owner of the remaining part of said Schooner, and both are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the said Schooner or Vessel called the *Kath Star* whereof Eugene Newman is at present Master; and as he hath sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo New York in the year 1853, as appears by her enrollment dated at this Port November 1st 1853, No 175 now succeeded changed Owners,

And such enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has One deck and two masts and that her length is 120 feet her breadth 25 " Gueches her depth 9 " 8 " and that she measures 300 tons 94 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner and has a Scull head

And the said Mortimer Wickie and having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N Y. Given under my Hand and Seal of Office, at the Port of Buffalo, in the said District, this 15 day of September in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty four
