In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of ~~Refugees on board Ships propelled in whole or in part by Steam~~" passed 7th July, 1822, and the Act of August 20th, 1852, ~~the same~~; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

E. P. Williams of Buffalo New York Managing owner
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Buffalo and is the Managing owner of the Propeller Frederick Follett of Buffalo and owns 1/3 part undivided of said Propeller; that William J. Fargo also resides at said Buffalo and owns one equal undivided third part of said Propeller; & that William H. B. Smith resides at Chicago Illinois and owns the remaining one third part undivided of said Propeller, and all said owners are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Propeller or Vessel called the Frederick Follett of Buffalo whereof said Smith is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1852, as appears by her last Enrollment dated at this port June 7, 1853 No 92 now surrendered having changed owners

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has and deck and no masts and that her length is 70 feet 11 inches her breadth 15 " 3 " her depth 6 " 10 " and that she measures 87 tons 63 ninety-fifths that she is a Propeller has no figure

And the said E. P. Williams having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N Y.
