In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same, also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Hiram Harrison, of Brant Erie County N.Y. Managing owner - having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Brant and is the Managing owner of the Sloop Watchman of Buffalo; and owns the equal undivided half part of said sloop; that Hiram B. Ostrum resides in Brant Erie County N.Y. and owns the remaining one equal undivided half part of said sloop, and that both said owners are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owners of the Sloop Watchman of Buffalo whereof said Harrison is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Evans State in the year 1854, as appears by her last Enrollment dated at this port June 29, 1854 No 134. Now surrendered having changed owners

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Sloop or Vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 71 feet 1 inch her breadth 17 " 1 " her depth 4 " 0 " and that she measures 45 tons 72 ninety-fifths that she is a Sloop and a square head

And the said Hiram Harrison having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Sloop has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N.Y.
