Walker, of said Buffalo owns one equal undivided third Part of said Brig and that Ramsey R. Brown who resides at said Buffalo owns the remaining One equal undivided One third Part of said Brig Sultan of Buffalo and that all of them are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owners of the Brig Sultan of Buffalo whereof Ramsey R. Brown is at present Master; and as he hath sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Chicago State of Illinois in the year 1848, as appears by her last enrollment dated at this Port September 1st 1854 No 179 New enrolled having changed owners
