



ENROLLMENT.



District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, ~~and the Act of August 20th, 1850, amending the same~~ also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Amasa J. Kingman of Buffalo New York, having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Buffalo and owns one equal undivided third part of the Propeller *Potomoth* of Buffalo and that *John G. Camp* Jr. owns 2/3d parts undivided of said Propeller and resides at Sandusky Ohio; and that said owners are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owners of the Propeller *Potomoth* or Vessel called the *Potomoth* of Buffalo whereof said *Kingman* is at present Master; and as he hath sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1853, as appears by her last Enrollment dated at this Port May 25, 1853 No 86 now surrendered having changed owners

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has two decks and one mast and that her length is 176 feet and 4 inches her breadth 29 " " 0 " her depth 10 " " 10 " and that she measures 535 tons 57 ninety-fifths that she is a Propeller has a square stern and no figure head

And the said *Amasa J. Kingman* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N Y.
