In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Ships propelled in whole or in part by Steam" passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1859, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1859.

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Black Rock New York, State of New York in the year 1850, as appears by the affidavits of said Prouty and William Palmerton of Buffalo on file in this office \_\_\_\_\_

And Thos Hoffman Surveyor \_\_\_\_\_ having certified that the said Schooner - or Vessel has one deck \_\_\_\_\_ and two masts \_\_\_\_\_ and that her length is \_\_\_\_\_ 96 feet and 4 inches her breadth \_\_\_\_\_ 19 " " 8 " her depth \_\_\_\_\_ 6 " " 2 " and that she measures \_\_\_\_\_ 107 \_\_\_\_\_ tons 87 \_\_\_\_\_ ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner \_\_\_\_\_ has a square stern \_\_\_\_\_ and no figure head  
And the said James Prouty \_\_\_\_\_ having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner \_\_\_\_\_ has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N.Y.
