PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better sailing of the lives of Buffaloes on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1854, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Watson A. Foy, Merchant, Buffalo Dist. of Buffalo Creek having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Buffalo and owns one equal undivided half part of the Brig Grey Horned of Buffalo and is the managing owner of said Brig; that Greenleaf W. Norris and William B. Hibbard both reside at said Milwaukee in the State of Wisconsin and as the assignees of the estate and property of Thomas P. Williams of the same place for the benefit of his creditors are the owners of the remaining one equal undivided half part of said Brig, and that all of them are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owners of the said Brig Grey Horned or Vessel called the Grey Horned of Buffalo - whereof Watson A. Foy is at present Master; and as he hath sworn Watson A. Foy is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Courmant in the State of Ohio in the year 1853, as appears by her last Enrollment issued at the Port dated April 12, 1854 No. 63, now surrendered having changed owners

And said Enrollment Watson A. Foy having certified that the said Brig Grey Horned or Vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 130 feet her breadth 28 " her depth 11 " and that she measures 367 tons and that she is a Brig has a square stern and a scroll head

And the said Watson A. Foy having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig Grey Horned has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
