In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels, propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1822, and the Act of August 20th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Marenius Dimick, of Buffalo N. Y. District of Buffalo Creek having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Buffalo and is the Managing owner of the Schooner "Robert Bruce" of Buffalo N. Y. and owns 1/3 part undivided of said Schooner; that the firm of Buell & Moore of said Buffalo, composed of J. Shadr Buell & William Moore both of said Buffalo own 1/3 part undivided of said Schooner; that Greenbald D. Norris and William B. Hibbard both of Milwaukee Wisconsin, as assignees of the Estate and effects of Thomas P. Williams of the same place for the benefit of his creditors are the owners of the remaining 1/3 part of said Schooner; and that said owners are
