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In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850. Augustus C Taylor of Buffalo N.Y.

Managing Owner

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo N.Y. in the District of Buffalo, and is the owner of one equal undivided half Part of the Brig of R. Hildreth of Buffalo, and that John, L. Justice who resides at Buffalo N.Y. is the owner of the remaining one equal undivided half part of said Brig and said vessel is employed in the service of Taylor & Justice at Buffalo and every

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Brig of R. Hildreth or Vessel called the *Thurs* whereof Augustus C Taylor is at present Master; and as he hath sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Ashland Ohio in the year 1844, as appears by the enrollment dated at this port November 1, 1851 No 84 New Summited heavy champed arms,

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Brig or Vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is one hundred and fourteen feet 114 ft and her breadth twenty five feet & eight inches 25 ft 8 in and her depth nine feet and eight inches 9 ft 8 in and that she measures two hundred & fifty seven tons fully nine ninety-fifths that she is a Brig and has no forecast head

And the said Augustus C Taylor agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Augustus C Taylor has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N.Y.
