In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1850, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Lee First Bank of Buffalo a corporation existing under the laws of the State of New York, that said Bank is the

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner Gardis Burchard of Buffalo whereof Thomas G. Crosby is at present Master; and as he hath sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Harro in the State of Ohio in the year 1847, as appears by her last Enrollment dated at this Port April 14, 1854 No. 71 now surrendered having changed owners

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has one deck and two masts her length is 107 feet and 6 inches her breadth 24 " 3 " her depth 8 " 4 " and that she measures 196 tons 63 that she is a Schooner has a scroll ninety-fifths

And the said Henry L. Lansing head having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
