In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the laws of Pennsylvania, and to amend the same," passed 7th July, 1829, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

George W. Washburn of Buffalo New York

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he is the managing owner of the Schooner Trenton of Buffalo, is a resident of the District of Buffalo Creek and owns one equal undivided half part of said Schooner and that Samuel Wood who resides at the same place is the owner of the remaining one equal undivided half part of said Schooner and that both said owners are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner Trenton of Buffalo whereof said Wood is at present Master; and he hath sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Black River Ohio in the year 1843, as appears by her last Enrollment dated at this Port February 4th 1854 eto. 9 now surrendered having changed owners

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has One deck and two masts and that her length is 84 feet and 10 inches her breadth 21 " " 5 " her depth 8 " " 6 " and that she measures 132 tons 11 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has no gallery and a scroll head

And the said George W. Washburn having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said

has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N.Y. Given under my Hand and Seal of Office, at the Port of Buffalo, in the said District, this 28 day of April in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty five
