In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th January, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838 and the Act of August 30th, 1850, ~~and the Act of August 30th, 1850, and the Act of August 30th, 1850, and the Act of August 30th, 1850,~~ also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850. Henry M. Kinney of Buffalo N.Y. one of the firm of Kinney and Kinney of Buffalo and as sole firm managing owners of the Schooner Enterprise

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Buffalo; that said Schooner is owned by the said Firm, which is composed of Joseph and Hiram Miles of Buffalo; each owning equal interest in said Schooner; that said owners are

Citizens of the United States, and sole owners of the said Schooner Enterprise of Buffalo or Vessel called the Enterprise of Buffalo whereof Lymon Wilson is at present Master; and as he hath sworn Wilson is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1855 as appears by the certificate of J. N. Jones of Buffalo N.Y. Shipwright on file in this office;

And Phonix Hoffman Surveyor having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 121 feet and 9 inches her breadth 25 " 10 " her depth 10 " 3 " and that she measures 290 tons 14 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square stern and a scroll head

And the said Henry M. Kinney having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N Y.
