In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852 amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

James Butler of Buffalo Dist. of Buffalo Creek
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Buffalo and is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner - or Vessel called the
Wm. W. Brigham of Buffalo whereof Nelson Humphrey of Ashutoula Ohio
is at present Master; and as he hath sworn
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Cattaraugus Creek State of
New York in the year 1849, as appears by her last Enrollment dated at
this port May 4, 1854 - No. 103 now surrendered having
changed owners -

And said Enrollment having
the said Schooner or Vessel has one deck and two masts and that
her length is 90 feet 7 3/4 inches
her breadth 20 " 7 1/2 "
her depth 7 " 12 1/2 "
and that she measures 16 tons 16 ninety-fifths
that she is a Schooner has

And the said Schooner and James Butler head
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with
the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N Y.
