In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled, "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

*Elijah N. Parice of Buffalo N.Y.*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo in the District of Buffalo Creek N.Y. and is the owner of one equal undivided half part of the Schooner Constellation of Buffalo and that John H. Lockwood who resides at Buffalo N.Y. is the owner of the remaining equal undivided half part of said Schooner Constellation an both of them

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner Brig, or Vessel called the Constellation of Buffalo whereof is at present Master; and as he hath sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Albany* State of *Ohio* in the year 185-, as appears by her last enrollment dated at this port April 8th 1852, No 110, now sumitted having changed owners,

And said Enrollment the said Brig or Vessel has *One deck* and *Two masts* having certified that her length is *118 feet 6 in* and that her breadth is *26 " 5 "* and her depth is *9 " 2 "* and that she measures *260* tons *34* ninety-fifths that she is a *Brig* has a scroll,

And the said *Elijah N. Parice* and *John H. Lockwood* head having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N.Y.
