In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Rufus C. Palmer, President of the American Transportation Company, having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is the President of said Company, a Corporation created by and operating under the laws of the State of New York and having its principal place of business at Buffalo N.Y. and that said Company is

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Propeller or Vessel called the Milwaukee whereof A. Howard is at present Master; and as he hath sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Cleveland State of Ohio in the year 1853, as appears by her last enrollment dated at this Port 25 April 1855 no 19 New Sunward having changed name

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has One deck and One Mast and that her length is 185 feet and 3 in her breadth 28 " " 0 " her depth 12 " 6 " 5 " and that she measures 616 tons 114 ninety-fifths that she is a Propeller and has a round Stern and a Scull head

And the said Rufus C. Palmer and A. Howard having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N Y. Given under my Hand and Seal of Office, at the Port of Buffalo, in the said District, this 3 day of May in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty five
