In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better sailing of the laws of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 20th, 1852, ~~and the Act of August 20th, 1852, and the Act of August 20th, 1852, and the Act of August 20th, 1852,~~ also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

David Provost of Buffalo Dist of Buffalo Creek N.Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Buffalo and is the managing owner of the Schooner Magnolia of Buffalo N.Y. and owns one equal undivided half part of the said Schooner and that John Newkirk of the same place owns the remaining one equal undivided half part of said Schooner and that both said owners are

Citizen of the United States and sole proprietor of the Schooner Magnolia or Vessel called the Magnolia of Buffalo whereof Charles A. Gardner of Buffalo is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Black River State of Ohio in the year 1845, as appears by her last Enrollment dated at this port on March 15, 1854 No 420 and surrendered at this port June 29, 1855, having changed owners

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 95 feet and 3 inches her breadth 28 " " 4 1/2 " her depth 9 " " 4 1/2 " and that she measures 198 tons 88 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner and has a square stern and

And the said David Provost head having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
