Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Huron in the State of Ohio and altered from a Steam Boat to a Propeller at Buffalo N.Y. in the year 1849, as appears by her last Enrollment dated at this port January 11th. 1854 and now surrendered having changed name

And the said Enrollment she said Propeller or Vessel has One deck and no masts and that her length is 131 feet 11 inches her breadth 25 " 5 " her depth 7 " 9 " and that she measures 241 tons and that she is a Propeller has ninety-fifths

And the said Refus C. Palmer Pres. &c. head having agreed to the description and advertisement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N.Y.
