In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "~~An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam,~~" passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 29th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner *Philema Mills of Buffalo*, whereof *James W. Zutter of Buffalo* is at present Master; and as he hath sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Chicago* in the year 1844, as appears by *the* *Pat of Chicago* the *May 9* 1851. No 13 New *last enrollment dated at* *having changed owners*

And the said enrollment the said Schooner or Vessel has *one deck* and *two masts* having certified that her length is *107 feet 2 in* her breadth *25 " 1 1/2 "* her depth *9 " 4 1/4 "* and that she measures *227* tons *29* and a *perce* *head* that she is a *Schooner* has a *bejrard stem* *ninety-fifths*

And the said *Henry N. Melo* and *a perce* head having agreed to the description and measurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Schooner* has been duly Enrolled at the *Port of Buffalo, N Y.* Given under my Hand and Seal of Office, at the Port of Buffalo, in the said District, this *7* day of *May* in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty five
