In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Rufus C. Palmer of Buffalo N.Y.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Buffalo and is the president of the American Locomotion Company a corporation created by and existing under the laws of the State of New York and having its principal place of business at Buffalo, and that said Corporation is

~~Citizen of the United States~~, and sole owner of the Propeller Depot of Buffalo whereof John H. Montgomery is at present Master; and as he hath sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Detroit Michigan in the year 1845, as appears by her last Enrollment dated at this Port April 26th, 1854 No 94 now surrendered having changed owners

And the said Enrollment she said Propeller or Vessel has *one deck* and *two masts* having certified that her length is *128 feet 6 inches* and that her breadth is *23 " 0 "* her depth is *9 " 10 "* and that she measures *293* tons *71* ninety-fifths that she is a *Propeller* has

And the said *Rufus C. Palmer* and *Palmer* head having agreed to the description and measurements above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Propeller* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N.Y.
