PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Pearl L. Shruberg of Buffalo in the District of Buffalo Creek, N. Y., having taken or subscribed the Oath, required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Buffalo and is the Managing owner of the Propeller Plymouth of Buffalo; that the equal undivided fifteen sixteenth part of said Propeller is owned by said Shruberg, Levi H. Russell, George H. Bryant of said Buffalo, Addison Rice & Everett Clapp of the City of New York as, and comprising the firm of P. L. Shruberg & Co. of Buffalo, and that the one equal undivided sixteenth part of said Propeller is owned by George H. Gibson of Cleveland Ohio; and that said owners are all of them

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Propeller Plymouth of Buffalo whereof George H. Gibson is at present Master; and as he hath sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Ohio being a State of Ohio in the year 1854, as appears by her last enrollment dated at this Port 12th May 1854 No 119, now amended having changed.

And the said enrollment having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has One deck and One mast and that her length is 212 feet 6 3/4 inches her breadth 32 " 10 1/2 " her depth 12 " 10 1/2 " and that she measures 846 tons 40 ninety-fifths that she is a Propeller and has a square stern and a scroll head

And the said Pearl L. Shruberg agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
