In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 20, 1850.

Refus L. Palmer of Buffalo N.Y. District of Buffalo Creek

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Buffalo and is the President of the American Transportation Company, a Corporation existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of New York and having its principal place of business at said Buffalo and that said Corporation is

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Propeller or Vessel called the Ohio of Buffalo whereof William Kennedy is at present Master; and as he hath sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Black River State of Ohio in the year 1848, as appears by her last Enrollment dated at this port April 20, 1853 No. 64, which as appears by the affidavit of John R. Wheeler on file in this office has been lost or unintentionally mislaid - said vessel having changed owner

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has two decks and one mast and that her length is 159 feet 4 1/2 inches her breadth 25 9/2 " her depth 11 3/4 " and that she measures 441 tons 1/2 ninety-fifths that she is a Propeller and has a round stern

And the said Refus L. Palmer and head having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N.Y.
