In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1834; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1850, amending the same, also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

William Sutton of Buffalo N.Y. Managing owner

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, and is the owner of the equal undivided third part of the Brig schooner of Buffalo, and that Hugh Davis who resides at Buffalo is the owner of the equal equal undivided third part of said Vessel, and Henry D. Woodruff of the City of New York is the owner of the remaining equal undivided third part of said Brig, and an

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Brig Schooner *Supera of Buffalo* whereof *G. Minceden* is at present Master; and as he hath sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at North east State of Pennsylvania in the year 1847 as appears by New York enrollment dated at this port 22 April 1854 now surrounded having changed owned,

And the said enrollment having certified that the said Brig or Vessel has One deck and two masts and that her length is 100 feet her breadth 25 " 2 1/2 in her depth 10 " " and that she measures 253 tons 81, ninety-fifths that she is a Brig has

And the said William Sutton and head having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig -- has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N Y.
