In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and ~~in the Act of August 30th, 1850, amending the same~~ also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Rufus C. Palmer of Buffalo N.Y. District of Buffalo Creek N.Y.,
having taken or subscribed the Oath, required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo and is President of the American Transportation Company, a corporation under the laws of the State of New York, having its principal place of business at Buffalo N.Y. That said Corporation owns, in equal undivided shares three parts of the Propeller Toledo of Buffalo, and that George W. Holt, who resides at said Buffalo, is the owner of the remaining a equal undivided One third part of said Propeller & an

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Propeller Toledo of Buffalo whereof he is at present Master; and as he hath sworn
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo New York in the year 1854, as appears by Log book Certificate of Enrollment dated on this 19th April 1854 No 80 now owned by George W. Holt, having certified that

And said Enrollment the said Propeller or Vessel has One deck her length is 178 feet 8 inches her breadth 29 " 2 " her depth 11 " 10 " and that she measures 585 tons that she is a Propeller has a square stem ninety-fifths

And the said Rufus C. Palmer and George W. Holt agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
