In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 20th 1850 amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

John Butterfield of Utica in the State of New York
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Utica -
and purchased the Steamboat called the Hendrick Hudson of Buffalo
on the 26th day of January 1855 she then and now being at the
Port of Buffalo in the District of Buffalo Creek

And that he is a
Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the said Steamboat or Vessel called the
Hendrick Hudson whereof
is at present Master; and as he hath sworn
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Cleveland State of
Ohio in the year 1840, as appears by her last Enrollment issued at this
office dated Jan 23^d 1854 - No 137 now surrendered having
changed owners

And said Enrollment having certified that
the said Steamer or Vessel has one deck and one mast and that
her length is 204 feet 8 inches
her breadth 32 " 5 "
her depth 12 " 5 "
and that she measures 750 tons 46 ninety-fifths
that she is a Steamboat has a round
stem and head

And the said John Butterfield having
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with
the terms of the said acts, the said Steamer has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N Y.
