In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Wells D Walbridge of Buffalo in the District of Buffalo Creek  
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he is resident said Buffalo and is the Secretary of the American Transportation Company, a corporation created by and existing under the laws of the State of New York, having its principal place of business at said Buffalo; that said company is the owner of one equal undivided fourth part of the Propeller Sun of Buffalo; that Amos R. Cobb is a Citizen of the United States, and owns the remaining three equal undivided one fourth parts of said Propeller; that no foreigner has any interest directly or indirectly, and that said company and said Cobb are the

Citizen of the United States, and sole owners of the Propeller  
Sun of Buffalo whereof Nicholas Edward is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1854. as appears by her last Enrollment dated at this port. July 24<sup>th</sup> 1854 No 159. Now surrendered having changed owners

the said Propeller - or Vessel has one deck and one mast and that her length is 191 feet and 4 inches her breadth 28 " " 6 " her depth 12 " " 11 " and that she measures 629 tons 32 ninety-fifths that she is a Propeller has a square stern and no figure

And the said Wells D. Walbridge agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller head having been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N Y. Given under my Hand and Seal of Office, at the Port of Buffalo, in the said District, this 2 day of June in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty five -
