In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 20th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

John Martin of Buffalo New York
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Buffalo and is the Managing owner of the said Propeller St. Joseph of Buffalo N.Y.; and owns one equal undivided half part of said Propeller, that Horace Cook resides at Westerland Oneida Co, and owns the remaining one equal undivided half part of said Propeller and said owners are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the said Propeller or Vessel called the St. Joseph of Buffalo N.Y. whereof John Martin of Buffalo is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1846, as appears by her last Enrollment dated at this office July 28, 1857 No 57. Now surrendered having changed owners

And said enrollment having certified that the said Propeller - or Vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 170 ft 14 inches her breadth 25 " 10 1/2 " her depth 10 " 5 3/4 " and that she measures 460 tons 16 ninety-fifths that she is a Propeller and has a figure

And the said John Martin head having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N Y. Given under my Hand and Seal of Office, at the Port of Buffalo, in the said District, this 5 day of June in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty
