In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Reuben Dill of Buffalo New York Managing owner

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, District of Buffalo Creek and owns three equal undivided One fourth part of the Schooner called the Virginia Purdy of Buffalo that Samuel Smith of Medford Massachusetts, and Benjamin C Adams of Buffalo, Parker H Barry and Charles P Chamblain of Boston each own the one equal undivided One eighth part of said Schooner and all said above named owners are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owners of the said Schooner or Vessel called the Virginia Purdy of Buffalo whereof said Dill is at present Master; and as he hath sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Ohio City Ohio in the year 1847, as appears by New York enrollment dated at this port January 28th 1854 No. 6 New Brunswick having changed

the Enrollment And Enrollment the said Schooner or Vessel has One deck and Two masts having certified that her length is 125 feet her breadth 25 " 4" her depth 11 " 3" and that she measures 301 tons 46 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a scroll and head

And the said Reuben Dill agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N Y. Given under my Hand and Seal of Office, at the Port of Buffalo, in the said District, this 9 day of June in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty five
